Nine of us did our best Saturday morning to look though the dense cloud layer and try and see the tops of the trees we were standing right next to. It was a bit difficult, and it was a bit chilly (for August). Nonetheless we persevered, the sun came out eventually, and we came away having tallied 31 species (see list below).

Among the highlights was a juvenile Red-tailed Hawk impersonating an Anhinga, while trying to dry out from a soggy

night. Good effort was put in on learning a bit about flycatchers, with multiple close looks at Western Wood-Pewees and Cordilleran Flycatchers.

We also were fortunate to pick up a few interesting migrants, an Orange-crowned Warbler and a Lazuli Bunting. Finally, perhaps the real highlight of the morning was getting to have numerous Evening Grosbeaks perched all around us in the fog and calling.
