Evergreen Audubon held our “Global Big Day” a day early for this year’s Dawn Chorus at Evergreen Lake. Ed Furlong, Melissa Leasia, Lisa Wald, Dwight Souder and others got the coffee on by 6:00 am as 32 of us headed out to see what we could discover. A duck species and three Western Grebes were on the Lake and Spotted Sandpipers scooted out from the shore. We could not entice any rails from the marsh, although a Marsh Wren and White-faced Ibis were seen. A walk to Wilmot Creek produced some of the best birds of the day, including a Clay-colored Sparrow, Orange-crowned Warblers, and a Dusky Flycatcher. Ed and David Wald found an American Dipper at the bridge past the Keys increasing the morning’s Lake list to 43 species.

After the early morning at the Lake, I headed to Elk Meadow, where I was joined by Pat Carter, to check nest boxes. We added an additional eight species there for a total Evergreen morning of 51 species. Thanks to everyone who came out and provided breakfast treats. The list is below.
