For the entire month of June 2018, Evergreen Audubon and the Center for the Arts Evergreen will jointly host the Audubon Roadshow of 2017's Best Avian Photography, featuring larger-than-life prints of the top 12 photographs. The show opens with a Reception on Thursday evening, June 7, and runs through June 27 at the Center for the Arts on Rocky Village Road, Bergen Park, Evergreen.

Selected from more than 5,500 entries, the winning photos show birdlife at its most vivid, vulnerable, formidable, and elegant. Photographers from 49 states and eight Canadian provinces submitted images in three categories: professional, amateur, and youth. A

panel of five judges had the daunting task of sifting through the stunning images and selecting the top 100 based on technical quality, originality, and artistic merit.

Visiting the Art Center to see the top 12 entries is only part of our June celebration of the Year of the Bird. Evergreen Audubon and the Center for the Arts have planned a plethora of exciting events throughout the month. Our schedule includes two photography-focused bird walks and a workshop on bird photography with noted Evergreen photographer, Jackie Crivello, and the birds from HawkQuest. We have engaged Kittredge artist Ruthann Fisher to lead a session on Birds and Origami, with children welcome, and invited Evergreen artist Lynne Milliken to hold a summer solstice morning on field sketching at The Evergreen Nature Center on Evergreen Lake. We have also planned a joint event with the Evergreen Camera Club. Ellen Nelson and a group of camera enthusiasts will help you learn how to take better pictures and use your camera effectively (any type of camera).
