As Colorado begins lifting restrictions on activities associated with the COVID-19 outbreak, Evergreen Audubon will be offering some adjusted programming. First and foremost, Evergreen Audubon values the continued good health of our members, staff and participants. Activities will only occur if we can meet recommendations of the state and county. The Evergreen Nature Center is open to visits by appointment only. Our social distancing protocol for outdoor nature walks is below.

Nature Walk Social Distancing Protocol

All free and fee-based outdoor programs and nature walks will allow a maximum of 8 program participants.

One or two Evergreen Audubon staff or volunteers may lead the walk/program so as not to exceed 10 people in the group.

Program leaders MUST wear masks and adhere to 6ft spacing between participants for social distancing.

Program participants will be asked to wear masks for the duration of the program or walk.

Program participants must keep a 6ft distance between one another and the program leader(s).

Program participants can stand or walk closer together if they come from the same household/family or party.

Evergreen Audubon program leaders will not be arranging or encouraging carpooling to program sites.

Program leaders and participants will not share binoculars, spotting scopes, hand lenses or other tools during the program.

If any program leader or participant is sick, OR if anyone in their family is sick, that person is required to stay home.

Hand washing and the use of hand sanitizer is highly encouraged when possible before, during and after the program.
