There are volunteer opportunities again with Evergreen Audubon! We opened up the Evergreen Nature Center with adapted exhibits for COVID safety and new sanitizing protocol. The Nature Center is open Tuesdays through Sundays by reservation only for one hour private visits of family groups of 8 or less. For those who are comfortable with and interested in volunteering as a Visitor Assistant at the Evergreen Nature Center, we are opening up shifts and providing new training opportunities.

We will also be teaming up with Denver Parks and Recreation and local organization Wild Aware to promote wildlife awareness and safe behavior while recreating outdoors. This new volunteer opportunity will include shifts beginning this fall and will focus on interacting with lake visitors, outdoors, and educating them about safe behavior around elk during rutting and calving seasons. Our goal will be to invite visitors to learn about our local wildlife from our volunteers while gaining an understanding of the dangers that can come with coexisting so closely with wildlife. We hope that with these positive interactions we can become more visible in our community, create better environmental stewards and develop long lasting partnerships with Denver Parks and Recreation along with Wild Aware.
