

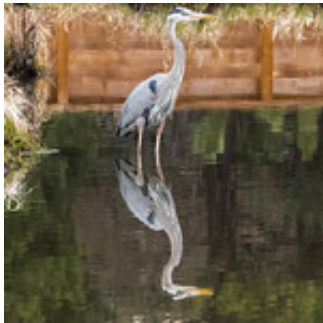
Check out the Flickers on Flickr!

Evergreen Audubon has a really cool Flickr page with hundreds of photos of birds, other wildlife, Evergreen Audubon events, and more, and you are welcome to check it out! It is really easy – just go to the Nature and Conservation drop-down menu, scroll down and click on Flickr. You will be redirected to our [Evergreen Audubon Flickr page](#).

When you first get there, the first thing you may see is a little paragraph about cookies. To prevent Flickr from adding their advertising to your searches click on the “manage my cookies” button and choose NO for all the advertisement cookies and for geotagging location. Do that and you can be sure of not having Flickr advertisements when you surf other sites.

Our [Flickr](#) photo library is a great tool to teach your child or grandchild the names of local birds. Once on our page, go to the albums tab and choose an album to view. Scroll through the pictures and choose what you are looking for. When you click on a picture you will see it enlarged and you can scroll down and see information about who took the picture and some other tidbits like the camera settings and maybe a little description by the photographer.

If you would like to use the photo publicly, please credit the photographer who took the picture.
