I hope you all had a joyful Thanksgiving. As you are aware, Jefferson County reinstated an indoor mask mandate the day before Thanksgiving to help reduce the spread of the Delta variant of COVID-19, as 100% of new cases are this variant. To comply with the JeffCo Public Health Order and to keep our members safe, Evergreen Audubon will take the following actions regarding a number of upcoming events over the next six weeks.



- December General Meeting. Masks will be required at the in-person general meeting on December 2, 2021, except for the speaker during his presentation. The meeting will be offered virtually through Zoom.
- 2. Christmas Bird Count Field Work (December 19, 2021). Participants can work in separate teams, using their own vehicle, or have a clear understanding of vaccination status in any multi-family parties. Section leaders should accommodate the needs and wishes of participants.
- 3. Christmas Bird Count Tally Rally (December 19, 2021). Being fully vaccinated is required to attend the Tally Rally. Masks should be worn accept for food or beverage consumption. We will not require proof of vaccination at the door, but rely on the honesty and integrity of our members and other participants. All section leaders should communicate this to their CBC participants.
- 4. Annual Banquet. As with the Tally Rally, participants should be fully vaccinated and be prepared to wear masks, accept for the meal or beverage consumption. We will not require proof of vaccination at the door, but rely on the honesty and integrity of our members and other attendees. The Public Health Order could be modified or canceled before the January 14, 2022 banquet date.
