

Partners Supporting Evergreen Audubon

Based on the application we submitted to the [Scientific and Cultural Facilities District \(SCFD\)](#) last March, we were awarded a \$22,141.96 General Operating Support Grant for 2022. Thanks to SCFD and the Jefferson County Cultural Council for the continued support of Evergreen Audubon's nature education programs. The SCFD is a seven-county tax district created within Colorado law, approved by the Colorado General Assembly, and renewed by voters multiple times over the last 30 years. Just one penny on every \$10 in sales and use tax collected goes to SCFD. This money is then given out annually, according to an allocation formula, to qualifying organizations in three ways: 1) the metro area's largest cultural organizations, such as the Denver Museum of Nature & Science (Tier I); 2) regional organizations like the Butterfly Pavilion (Tier II); small county organizations like Evergreen Audubon (Tier III). Since 2009, we have received \$181, 379 of Tier III funding from SCFD.



At the end of October, we also received a check of \$1,700 from Team Evergreen for our volunteer contributions to the Triple Bypass. Thanks, Team Evergreen for supporting local non-profits.
